**DAY 1**

Farewell meal in a local restaurant and overnight in Stirling or Glasgow.

Optional morning excursion\* to Linlithgow, birthplace of Mary Queen of Scots, or take part in a 'Learn the Bagpipes' workshop at the National Piping Centre in Glasgow.
